Virtua to Go Live With a Single Ultrasound Compendium, June 10

On Tuesday, June 10, Virtua is going live with the first phase of a project to develop a single Radiology Compendium to be used throughout Virtua, replacing the three compendia used to order radiology exams. The first phase will include a single Ultrasound Compendium. In addition to the ultrasound go-live on June 10, please see below for a full listing of anticipated launches:

- Tuesday, Sept. 23, 2025 – CT Single Compendium
- Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2025 – Mammography Single Compendium
- Tuesday, March 24, 2026 – X-Ray Single Compendium
- Tuesday, June 23, 2026 – Nuclear Medicine Single Compendium

This effort aims to alleviate clinicians' confusion in the order process, standardize terminology across the organization using the national Logical Observation Identifiers Names and Codes (LOINC) mapping, allow for cross-checking of radiology orders, and enable Happy Together imaging in Epic.

To help ease this transition, the project team has compiled [this crosswalk](#) that lists the old order ID, the old order name, the new order ID, and the new order name.

Additionally, all universal preference lists will be updated with the new order IDs, however, any personalized preference lists will need to be manually updated. Tip sheets are available for assistance in editing these items:
