#### Moderna's COVID-19 Vaccine Boosters at Virtua Health

In compliance with the CDC's recommendations regarding booster doses of Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine, Virtua has started scheduling appointments for eligible colleagues at the Barry D. Brown Health Education Center (HEC).

The IT team is sending scheduling notifications via MyChart to colleagues who received their initial series of the Moderna vaccine at the HEC. The notices will come likely by way of an email from <a href="mailto:donotreply@virtua.org">donotreply@virtua.org</a>. Eligible colleagues without MyChart will receive an email or text message.

Walk-up vaccinations are **not** presently available. When selecting a date/time in MyChart, be sure to hit the red "Schedule" button in order to lock-in your appointment. You will be taken to a confirmation page and will likely receive a confirmation email (based on your communications settings).


Please remember the following before attending your booster appointment at the HEC.

- Use the eCheck-in feature in MyChart up to 48 hours before your appointment to quicken registration.
- Bring your CDC Vaccination Record Card to your appointment. If you are in need of a replacement card, please click <u>here</u> to access the request form.
- Park in the designated area. Consult the map before your vaccine appointment to ensure you park your vehicle in the correct area at the HEC.
- Wear a mask and practice social distancing during your vaccine appointment.

To Note: For simplicity and a straightforward process, Virtua will provide colleagues who originally received the Moderna vaccine with a Moderna booster. The same is true for Pfizer recipients. Anyone who prefers to receive a vaccine that is different from their previous series can visit a pharmacy or non-Virtua clinic for their booster. #### Wide-Awake Hand Surgery Offers New Options

In many cases, rest, medication, braces, and physical therapy will help relieve hand and wrist pain. For injuries that do require surgery, an innovative approach performed without general anesthesia can speed patients' return to everyday activities.

The technique, known as wide-awake local anesthesia, no tourniquet (WALANT), may be done in the surgeon's office, and in the same time as a normal appointment. Preoperative blood work and fasting

are not required, and patients may not need to stop their blood thinners. Patients experience faster recovery and less postoperative pain.

Conditions commonly treated with WALANT include trigger finger, tendon and ligament repairs, removal of masses and small tumors, and contractures.

"Patients are comfortable during the procedure without experiencing the side effects of full sedation," said Virtua hand and upper extremity surgeon Nathan Bodin, MD. "As they are wide awake, they can participate in the surgery, allowing our surgical team to check the integrity of the repair and make any necessary adjustments before we leave the procedure room."

# **Mandatory Flu Vaccination Program Closes Next Week**

The deadline for Virtua colleagues to receive the flu vaccine and remain in compliance with Virtua's mandatory flu vaccination program is 11:59 p.m. on **Tuesday**, **Nov. 2**. Effective **Wednesday**, **Nov. 3** at

12:01 a.m., colleagues who have not been vaccinated or did not present an approved exemption form are considered non-compliant. **To date, 59.86% of colleagues have received the vaccination.**

- Who Administered the Vaccine
- Address of Where the Vaccine Administered

# **Annual Mandatory Conflict of Interest Disclosure Available on Virtua Works**

Virtua colleagues who are director level and above and all employed health care providers (physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants) are required to complete the annual Conflict of Interest Disclosure Attestation by **Sunday, Oct. 31**.

Currently, **54%** have completed the annual Conflict of Interest.

#### Important Apple Device iOS Update Required

The IT department advises all Apple device owners to apply the latest update (15.0.2), which was just released from Apple to patch a critical vulnerability. If your device version is less than 15.0.2 for iOS/iPadOS, or 11.6. for MacOS Big Sur, your device is at risk of being compromised.

#### What does this mean?

Attackers that successfully exploit this vulnerability can steal data or install malware onto your device. This puts your personal information as well as confidential Virtua information at risk.

#### What do I need to do?

Apply the latest software update to your personal device.

## Which updates do I need?

- iOS and iPadOS to version 15.0.2
- MacOS Big Sur to version 11.6

#### What do I need to do if my Apple device syncs Virtua email?

- Update your iPhone, iPad to the required iOS version.
- Acquire a device that is compatible with the required versions of iOS and MacOS.
  - Older devices will not support the latest iOS upgrade and can't be patched.
  - Older devices will not support the most current critical security updates.

Why can't I continue to use my current/older device for syncing Virtua email without the upgrade? Any device without the required security updates will be restricted from syncing Virtua email for security protection reasons.

#### How do I update my device?

Follow these Apple steps to update your device:

- 1. Plug your device into power and connect to the internet with Wi-Fi.
- 2. Go to Settings > General, then tap "Software Update."
- 3. If you see two software update options available, choose the one that you want to install.
- 4. Tap "Install Now." If you see "Download and Install" instead, tap it to download the update, enter your passcode, then tap "Install Now." If you don't know your passcode, learn what to do.
- 5. You might see that your device is up-to-date on its current version, and there's an update available. For example, even if your device is up-to-date on the latest version of iOS 14, there might be an option to update to iOS 15.

#### What if my device is an older model and cannot be updated to the required versions?

- Acquire a device that is compatible with the required versions of iOS and MacOS.
- Older devices will not support the latest iOS upgrade and can't be patched.
- Older devices will not support the most current critical security updates.

#### A few tips to keep in mind:

- Do not download, accept, or execute files from untrusted and unknown sources.
- Do not visit untrusted websites or follow links provided by untrusted or unknown sources.
