

UPDATED EFFECTIVE MARCH 16

NEW VISITOR GUIDELINES

We have temporarily made changes to our visiting policy to minimize the potential spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

Effective immediately, Virtua will implement a no-visitation/no-access policy for all inpatient and outpatient locations, with limited exceptions for:

- ▶ Terminally-Ill Patients
- ▶ Laboring Mothers
- ▶ Neonatal Intensive Care Units
- ▶ Pediatric Patients
- ▶ Those serving as caregivers for patients undergoing same-day surgeries and procedures.

Washing Hands

For those limited visitors outlined above, you must wash or sanitize hands prior to entering patient care areas. If you are coughing or showing other signs of illness, you will be asked to kindly leave and visit remotely.
